ALCI ANTARCTIC FLIGHTS BT-67

- The Basler Turbo 67's are an updated version of the flight legend DC-3. The BT 67's are equipped with two Pratt and Whitney PT6A 67R turbo engines and use 5 blade 115" Hartzell propellers. This combination affords the aircraft a substantial increase in performance and reliability, more speed and more payload.
- The BT-67's are outfitted with HF/VHF radios and Iridium satellite communication equipment, as well as primary and secondary GPS navigation systems.
- The internal configuration can be adapted depending on the transport needs. The aircraft can operate as fully cargo or they can be equipped with a maximum of 18 passenger seats. For the Antarctic flights, the BT-67 is additionally equipped with SOS grab-bags containing elementary provisions, a first-aid kit and basic survival and signaling equipment. These aircraft are also supplied with Survival Bags containing vital equipment, including polar tents, stoves, fuel and provisions to support the crew and passengers for a week.
